In the Indian Census of 2001, 1,261,722 persons were listed as hearing disabled among the totals of 21,906,769 populations of disabled in India. Another study states that more than 25,000 children are born deaf in India every year and eight-ten percent of the adult population has hearing problems.

Deaf students require additional academic support in the form of Sign Language in order to understand and perform well in their courses. With this in mind, DEF began offering Indian Sign Language coaching programmes to students enrolled in various courses such as the Board of Intermediate Education and graduate courses (B. Com Computer Applications) at Annamalai University. Our instructors are well-trained and skilled, allowing students to successfully complete their course curriculum and perform well in their classes.

DEF Academy (Coaching Classes for Intermediate & Degree Students)

Deaf students require extra assistance in Indian Sign Language in order to comprehend and perform effectively in their classes. With this in mind, DEF organised Coaching Classes for students enrolled in various programmes offered by the Board of Intermediate Education for Higher Education, Annamalai University, and Andhra University. These students can complete their curriculum and do well in their classes with the help of a qualified and experienced instructor. Deaf students from DEF are currently enrolled in Intermediate courses at the Senior Secondary level, as well as Deaf students pursuing their Bachelor of Commerce degree in Computer Application through DEF's Coaching Classes at both Annamalai University and Andhra University. Our professors and coaches are ready to assist any deaf young students in Class.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

The DEF- Skill Development Training conducts Vocational Training Program Courses and is a major wing of DEF. The courses conducted by DEAF ENABLED FOUNDATION includes: a. Basic IT Skill DEF is working towards providing quality computer education to all Deaf persons so that they can be a part of the Indian work force and play a constructive part in the development of our land. The unique feature of our Computer Center is that our teachers and instructors are also Deaf and they teach the Deaf students through Indian Sign Language (ISL). DEF aims at creating a pool of talented IT workers from the Deaf community. It is our dream that every Deaf person passing out of this Center will be placed in companies of repute in the IT and other allied fields. We also encourage Deaf persons to take up self-employment. The Basic Computer Course and training in DTP helps the deaf student to become adept at working with a computer.





In Collaboration with L&T Construction CSR partner distributed Educational Kits to the Deaf Schools across the Chennai on 10th of December 2021.


